Following the instructions page, the participant will be exposed to one of the following vignettes regarding reputation. Please note that variations in the vignette are underlined.

*Country A is entering into a defensive alliance with Country B. Country A currently faces a military threat/no military threat. Country A does/does not expect to face a military threat in the future.*

*The text of the alliance states that, "if a member of this alliance is attacked, then all other members of the alliance are required to come to its defense by any means including political support, economic aid, and troops."*

*According to most experts, Country B's military and economic capabilities are significantly greater than/equal to/significantly less than Country A's military and economic capabilities.*

*Historically, Country B has consistently/inconsistently complied with alliance commitments. When Country B's alliance partners have experienced security crises in three recent events, Country B has always/has sometimes fulfilled its alliance commitments.*

Potential Vignette 2:

*Country A was attacked by a third country and Country B only partially complied with the terms of its alliance agreement with Country A. Specifically, Country B provided Country A with political support at the United Nations and sent additional resources. However, Country B did not send troops in support of Country A's defense.*

Potential Vignette 3:

*Country A was attacked by a third country and Country B did not fulfill any of the terms of its alliance agreement with Country A. Specifically, Country B did not provide Country A with political support at the United Nations, did not send additional resources and did not send support troops.*

The subject will then be asked about their updated beliefs regarding Country B's alliance relationships.
